

**Day 29 – Invite a Friend to Church Day****Read Hebrews 10:25**

Prayerfully consider someone to invite to church this week. Be praying about whom you should invite. Ask them to come with you to service on Sunday, offer to sit with them, or pick them up if they need a ride. You never know who is ready and waiting for an invitation. This could change their life forever!

**Day 30 – Pray for Salvation Day****Read: Philemon 1:6**

Today we are continuing to believe God for salvation for our unsaved friends, family, neighbors, and co-workers. Put little reminders throughout your home that will remind you to pray for those you have on your list. Perhaps a little sticky note on the fridge or bathroom mirror, or an alarm on your phone, find what works best for you! Pray for salvation today!

**Day 31 – Operation World Day****Read: Matthew 28:19**

God challenges us in our reading to make disciples of ALL nations. Today our focus is global outreach! There are numerous ways that we can partner with ministries across the world. Pray for a missionary, consider sending them a care package, ask God if he is calling you to go on a short term missions trip, consider sponsoring a child, listen to the voice of the Lord, maybe he is calling you to GO! **Day 32 – Spread the Word Day****Read: I Peter 3:15**

Today we will be spreading the Gospel through written form. Consider giving away a book that helped you on your faith journey, or find reading materials that could influence someone for Christ and leave them in a public place. Be praying for hearts to be open to receive the message of the Gospel.

**Day 33 – Reconciliation Day****Read: Galatians 3:28 and Ephesians 2:14-16**

Racism is an unfortunate part of living in a fallen world. While we have made strides over the years, we still have a long way to go. Today we are going to break down those barriers and show kindness and love to other people who may not be of the same race as we are. You can offer to buy them lunch, pray with them, give a gift, write an encouraging note, or listen to their concerns. The options are endless, but your kindness can plant a seed in their hearts for eternity! Pray that your acts of kindness can make a difference in their world.

**Day 34 -Victory Day!****Read: Daniel 4:27, I John 5:4**

Too many Christians have spent their entire Christian life living as slaves when Christ has purchased our freedom. Christ came that we might have life and have it more abundantly! Today we are going to renounce sin and strongholds in our lives and declare victory! Pray that the Lord will bring anything to light that is a stronghold in your life. You can write out the specifics and confess and receive God's forgiveness, then destroy the list as a symbol of letting go. Here are a few things that you may need to renounce: unforgiveness towards people in your past or present, renounce all Satanic influences such as tarot cards, physics, palm readings, seances, Ouija boards, etc., sexual sins, addictions-list any substances or behaviors you may be addicted to, abuses – verbal, emotional, sexual, psychological or even spiritual: received or given. Declare victory in your life today!

**Day 35 – Home Prayer Walk Day!****Read: Romans 12:1-3**

Joshua in the Old Testament made the declaration, "As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord." Dedicate your home to the Lord. It is best if your entire family joins together. Making this statement as a family will make a tremendous impact on your household! Choose to serve the Lord together and pray over your home today! Pray in every room; ask for the peace and presence of the Lord to fill every room, invite close friends and family to participate in praying for one another's home. Small groups may join together and go from home to home praying for each member's homes. Pray that your home is filled with the joy of the Lord. Ask the Lord to use your home in reaching lost people for Him.
