

Day 8 – Mentor Day**Read II Timothy 1:13-14**

Who is the person that has had the greatest impact on your life? It may be someone who led you the Lord, or a coach, a teacher, or parent. Find a way to let the person you know how he/she has impacted you. You may also want to do something special or that person such as write a note, call the person and thank them, or do something tangible to serve your mentor or bless them.

Day 9 - Prayer Walk**Read Joshua 1 and 6**

God promised Joshua that if he was bold and courageous to go into the land, God was going to give him every place his foot touched. If you will join with a friend or a group of Christians and walk around your neighborhood or workplace praying, you will see God begin to change the spiritual climate. Pray for those with whom you live and work. Ask God to save the lost. Ask God to set free those bound by addiction. Ask God to set Christians around you on fire for him.

Read and declare Joshua 6:2-5, I John 1:7, Luke 2:52, 2 Tim 1:7

Week 2 – Memorization

“Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely, I [Jesus] am with you always, to the very end of the age.” **Matthew 28:19-20**

Day 10 – Write A Note Day**Read James 2:1-3**

Today is all about demonstrating God’s love in a simple way. Write a note to someone with whom you wouldn’t typically associate with or to someone who is often alone or to someone who is discouraged. Write several encouraging notes.

Day 11 – Transportation Day**Read Matthew 10:32-33**

Transportation is a luxury that we can take for granted. We live in a country where most families have two cars, but in places all over the world people walk for miles. Today, thank the Lord for the blessing of transportation, but also pray for those who may not have transportation. Pray for God’s provision for the family that is in need of a new vehicle, the missionary overseas bringing the Gospel to others, or for the single mom who needs repairs, but doesn’t know how she can afford it.

If you have the means of helping someone with car repairs offer to help them or if someone needs gas money purchase a gift card and bless the person or family with it.

Day 12 – Bosses’ Day

Read: Galatians 6:6

Bosses play a significant role in our lives. If you let God use you in their lives, you will see Him do miracles. Pray for them; they need it. Serve them, even if you find them tough to love. Bless them! In doing so you will see them in a whole new way! Consider the following: pray for your boss. Ask your boss how you can pray for him/her. Be sure to write it down and follow up later regarding these requests. Write a note to let your boss know he/she is special and that you prayed for them today.

Day 13 – Hang Out Day

Almost everyone hangs out somewhere. There are numerous places that are great for outreach – the gym, sports arenas, work, movie theaters, etc... Today we are going to focus on these areas and step out of our comfort zone to share the love of Jesus in practical ways. Here are just a few examples of things you can do:

- 1) Drive/Walk by prayer – with a group of friends or by yourself drive around areas that people hangout and pray. Pray for salvation, pray against addiction, pray for God to move in our city, neighborhoods, schools, and families.
- 2) Give away free snacks, hot chocolate, soda, water, with a note about church. Explain it’s free because God’s love is free (This is a fun way to share the love of Jesus. Be creative. This list is just the beginning of ways that you can show others the love of Jesus. Pray. Ask God how he wants to use you and your family in your community, neighborhood, and circles of friends and family.)
- 4) Pray that God’s people will devote more time and attention to Him and His word.
- 5) Be alert and aware of ways that you can use sporting events and other outings as opportunities to shine a light for Jesus!
